Seven to eight papers are expected to be accepted as a total.

Applicants Graduate students, post-doctoral researchers, and other researchers on fixed-term contracts. (Domestic travel and accommodation expenses for in-person participants will be covered).

Discussion 25 minutes for the presenter, 10 minutes for the discussant, and 15 minutes for discussion by all participants. Discussants for each paper will be decided by the organizing committee. Presentation in English is also welcomed.
